### **Before You Start**

- Stabilizer choice

#### **Preparing to Embroider**

Hoop the fabric and stabilizer.

Install the bobbin.

Attach the hoop to the carriage on the embroidery machine.

Select your upper thread(s), cueing up colors in the order that they will be sewn.

## Selecting an Embroidery Pattern

Make sure that no objects or hands are near the embroidery unit and the needle is at its highest position.

Attach the hoop to the carriage on the embroidery unit.

Turn ON the machine by pressing the ON/OFF switch on the righthand side of the machine.

Press OK on the first screen shown at right.

Select your pattern from the next screen.




Check the pattern before stitching – press on the third screen.





The hoop moves to indicate the entire embroidering area.





## **Begin Embroidering**

Thread the first color in the upper spool pin.

Lower the presser foot.

Press the START/STOP button on the front and begin embroidering.

After progressing 5-6 stitches, stop the machine and cut off the excess thread at the beginning.

Press the START/STOP button again to continue embroidering.

The machine will automatically stop for all thread color changes.

Once the embroidery is complete, raise the presser foot and make sure the needle has returned to its highest position.

Remove the hoop by pulling the lever between the 2 guide tabs to the left, lift the hoop off the carriage and carefully slide it under the presser foot.
