Inserting the VHS
<p>Turn on the VCR using the power button on the left side of the machine.</p> <p>Insert your VHS tape in the slot to the left, with the labelled sides facing up and out.</p> <p>Make sure VHS is rewound to where you would like to begin recording.</p>

Getting Started With the Converter	
<p>Double-click "Elgato Video Capture" on the PC</p> <p>"GET STARTED" MENU</p> <p>Enter a name for your video in the "What is the name of this movie?" box</p> <p>Click "Preferences" and under "Save Movies In" select the location to save your file to</p> <p>Click "Continue"</p>	

Configuring the Converter

"CONNECT VIDEO" MENU

Press Play on the VCR

Ensure you can view the picture from your videocassette playing through the PC

Press Stop on the VCR

Click "Continue"

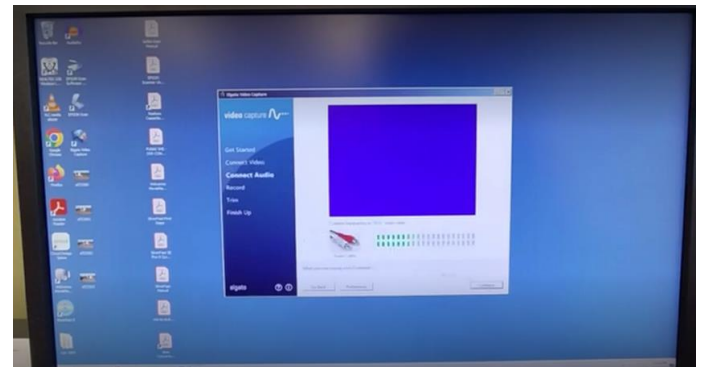
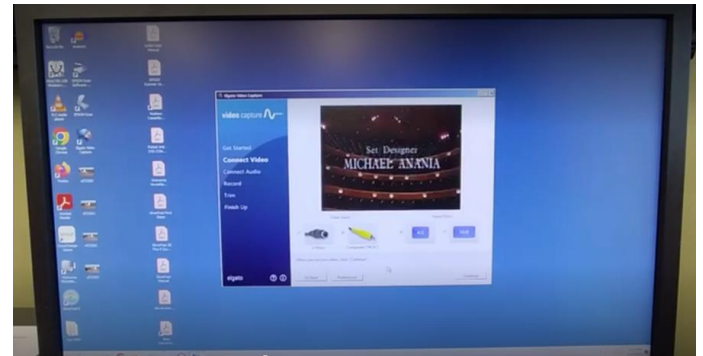
"CONNECT AUDIO" MENU

Press Play on the VCR

Ensure you can hear the audio from your videocassette playing through the PC

Press Stop on the VCR

Click "Continue"



Creating a File

"RECORD" MENU

Rewind videocassette to where you'd like to begin recording Click "Start Recording" (video will record in real time)

Press Play on the VCR

Click "Stop Recording" when finished

"TRIM" MENU

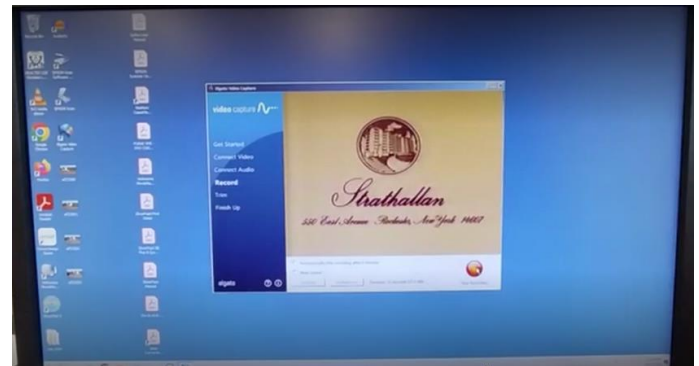
If you wish, trim portions of the beginning and/or ending of your file by sliding the triangles along the time bar.

Click "Continue" when finished

"FINISH UP" MENU

Your file will now be processed and saved in the location you selected earlier

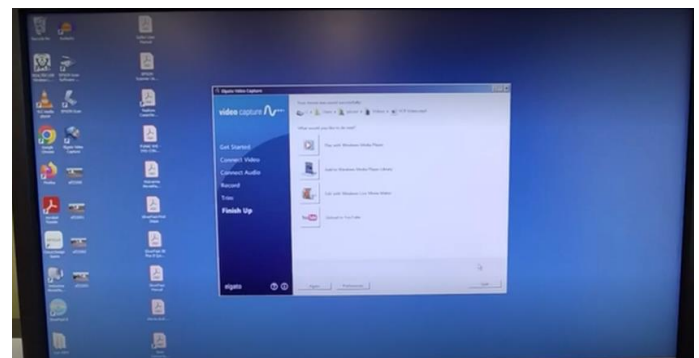
