All proceeds will be donated to the Irondequoit Public Library to support library programs and services that would not otherwise be possible.

To be eligible for this event, **all items offered for sale will be by a crafter/vendor, or offered for sale by a registered charitable not-for-profit entity.** All attendees must abide by the Code of Conduct of the Library during the event (attached).

TERMS

1. The participation fee is \$25 for a table on both Saturday and Sunday, \$20 for a table on Saturday only, and \$10 for a table on Sunday only. Initial here
2. To enable the Friends to assess your application, the application fee is due within 48 hours of agreeing to be part of the show. If the application and fee are not received within 48 hours, you risk the possibility of not being in the show. Entries are considered in order of application. Applications will be considered based on the stated show criteria. Initial here
3. You agree that sales tax for all sales is your sole responsibility and represent that to the extent required, you are registered to collect and remit sales tax as required by law. Initial here
4. You are required to stay for the entirety of the show. Initial here
5. There is no smoking (of any kind) on Library property. Initial here
6. The Friends cannot control foot traffic and cannot guarantee you will make sales the day of the show. For crafters, there may be similarities to others at the show. The Friends cannot guarantee you are the only crafter in your style of crafting. It is each crafter and vendor's job to help to promote these events by spreading the word and flyer- that is what helps the foot traffic. Initial here
7. Everyone that is accepted into the show, will be put into a group message/group page, through Facebook or email, provided you have Facebook. It is the fastest and easiest way to get information to everyone. Please be alert for this outreach. Initial here
8. The Friends will have a flyer made for the event, that we will share with you. Please share the flyer to help advertise. The Friends and affiliates will have an event page, will advertise on our FB pages, and other social networking sites. All promotion of the event must make it clear that this is not a program of the Library (it is the "Friends of the Library"). Initial here
9. In the event the Craft Fair must be cancelled (weather, power outage, pandemic, etc), it will be rescheduled for some time within the next ninety days. If you confirm in writing that you cannot attend the rescheduled event within ten days of being notified of the new date, your application fee will be refunded. Initial here
10. In the event you must cancel your appearance, we cannot offer a refund unless you are able to locate substitute. Initial here
11. If you will have employees working at the event, you represent that you have Worker's Compensation Insurance as required by law.

12. You agree to abide by all safety rules of the Irondequoit Library and to abide by all requests of the organizers related to safety and set-up on the day of the event. **Initial here**
