


Windows Instructions

Begin by connecting the small end of the provided cable (1) into the back of the ZenDrive. Connect the USB end of the cable (2) to your computer. You can push the button on the front of the ZenDrive to see if it's properly receiving power. If the ZenDrive doesn't open, try plugging the additional USB end (3) into another slot on your computer to provide additional power.




To view a CD or DVD, insert a disc into the ZenDrive and close the tray, then open File Explorer and click on "This PC" on the lefthand side. There you will see "DVD RW Drive". Double-click this to begin playing the disc in your computer's default media player app. If you would like to rip files from the CD or DVD, right click the drive and choose "Open" to see the files on the CD or DVD. Drag these files to your desktop or another folder to save them.

To burn files to a CD or DVD, insert a blank CD or DVD into the ZenDrive and open Windows Media Player Legacy on your computer. Click on the "Burn" tab in the top right and drag your files to where it says "Drag items here to create a burn list". When all of your files have been added, click "Start Burn". This process may take a while.

Mac Instructions

Begin by connecting the small end of the provided cable (1) into the back of the ZenDrive. Connect the USB end of the cable (2) to your computer. You can push the button on the front of the ZenDrive to see if it's properly receiving power. If the ZenDrive doesn't open, try plugging the additional USB end (3) into another slot on your computer to provide additional power.



To view a CD or DVD, insert a disc into the ZenDrive. An icon should show up on your desktop labeled "Audio CD" or "DVD". Double-click this to open the contents of the disc. To rip files from the CD or DVD, drag the files to your desktop or another folder to save them. Double-click on the files to play them.

To burn files to a CD or DVD, insert a blank CD or DVD into the ZenDrive and locate the files you want to burn to the disc on the computer using the Finder app. Select the files, right click, and select "Burn to disc" and follow the prompts.
